- 1. Welcome & Apologies. Cllr D May sent his apologies.
- 2. **Declarations of Interest.** There were no new declarations.
- 3. Election of Vice Chairman. Cllr Sam Langmead was unanimously voted as Vice chairman, and the Council resolved to instate him as such.
- 4. Agree & sign off last meeting's minutes. These were agreed & signed off by the chairman.
- 5. Parishioners' Questions. A letter was received from concerned residents regarding the speeding in Clay Lane, Crossbush; the condition of the road (potholes); and litter on the A27. The Clerk has reported all three issues to the relevant departments. There was discussion with the new PCSO, who attended the meeting. She was informed of the troublesome bend on the A284/Church Lane junction, and the need for some kind of deterrent to stop speeding traffic. Cllr Ashman mentioned the speeding motor bikes and cars that use the road as a racetrack. A police presence was requested at such times that this problem occurs. The PCSO said she would speak to her sergeant and to the traffic units in Arundel. She is involved in Speed Watch, so will put this on her agenda. Speed bumps were suggested but dismissed as apparently, they can cause problems with the foundations of houses along the road. The village of Washington has managed to acquire a speed camera. ACTION; Clerk to

contact them to ask how they acquired this. It was suggested that we contact the contractor Jackson, to see if they might be willing to help us purchase our own speed watch camera. ACTION; Clerk to contact Jackson. Burpham have managed to get their speed restrictions changed from 30 to 20mph. ACTION: Cllr Thompson to enquire as to how they did this.
